

GUIDELINES TO CONTRIBUTORS

'Abrahamia –An International Journal of Plant Sciences' published by the Department of Botany, University of Kerala invite original research papers including short communications and critical scientific reviews highlighting present status and an overview of the past work on topics of current interest. Submission of a manuscript implies that the submitted paper has not been published, not accepted or is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.

Submission of the manuscript: The manuscript should be submitted as soft copy addressed to Chief Editor, Department of Botany, University of Kerala, email: abrahamia.ajps@gmail.com

The receipt of the manuscript will be acknowledged and the acknowledgement will contain the manuscript number. Once a manuscript is submitted all correspondence regarding the submitted manuscript should refer to the manuscript number.

Format of the manuscript: The manuscript should be typed in double space, Times New Roman, 12 –font, A-4 size paper with one inch margin on all sides. The electronic version of text and figures should be in MS Office, photographs should be in JPG or JPEG format.

Title of the paper should be brief, bold (14 font size) centered near the top of the first page.

Author's (s) name(s) should be in bold, (12 font size) and affiliations in title case in italics. Arrangement of the text should be—Abstract, keywords, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Result, Discussion, Acknowledgements and References.

Abstract: All papers, including short communication, must have an abstract. Abstract should be in 10-font size, and usually not exceeding 250 words should indicate the scope and significant content of the manuscript highlighting the major findings.

Keywords: Up to five words which identify the most important subject covered by the paper and should be arranged in alphabetic order and separated by comma.

Running Title: Authors are requested to suggest a running title for their manuscripts.

Illustrations: Figures should be numbered consecutively using Arabic numerals. Line diagrams and inscriptions should be legible keeping in mind they may be reduced. Legends of the figures should be typed on a separate sheet, should be brief and self explanatory. Tables should also be numbered consecutively using Arabic numerals (Table-1, 2...) with a self – explanatory title.

Abbreviations should be explained in foot notes, otherwise standard abbreviations should be used, e.g.: ml (milliliter), g, (gram), l (liter), kDa (kilo Dalton), kb (kilo base) and symbols e.g.: α , β , μ , etc. All Latin binomial names should be italicized.

References should be listed in alphabetical order. Ensure before submission of manuscripts that all references cited in the text are listed under the references. Following style and pattern should be used while listing references.

In the text, references should appear as Cross and Schulz (1997) or (Cross and Schulz 1997). A semicolon (;) should be placed between two references, within the same parenthesis, after the year. In case of more than two authors, surname of the first author followed by et al. should be written.

All papers are reviewed by members of Editorial Board or external referees. The comments of referees/ editors are communicated to the authors for revision and incorporation of suggestions, before the paper is finally accepted by the Chief Editor.

Page Proof

After acceptance, page proof of the paper soft copy is sent to the corresponding author together with instructions for proof correction. Authors are requested returned to the Chief Editor within 72hrs of receipt, otherwise the paper will be published in the next issue.

One copy of the Journal in which the article appeared will be sent to authors as gratis.

Cover photographs: Each cover of *Abrahamia* may normally have a photograph corresponding to one selected article published in that issue.

25 reprints of the paper will be provided to corresponding author. Authors have to pay Rs.1000/- per accepted paper and an extra charge Rs. 4000/- per coloured plate, if desired, at the time of sending the corrected galley proofs. The DD be prepared in favour of Chief Editor, '*Abrahamia*', Department of Botany, University of Kerala.

A copy right transfer duly signed by all the authors is to be submitted along with corrected gallery proof of the manuscript.
